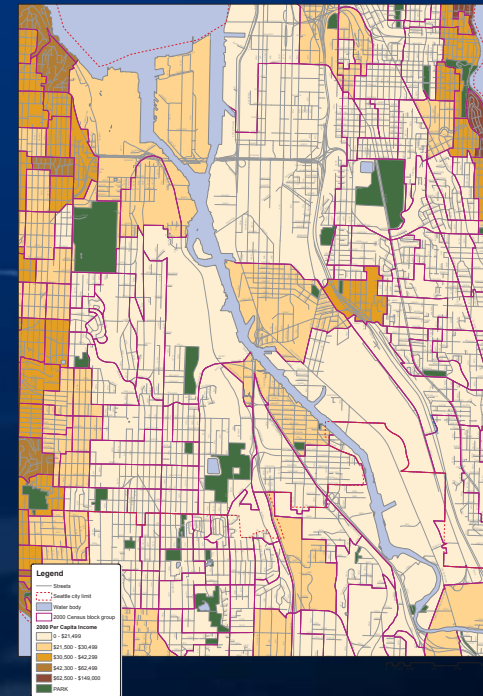
Cumulative Health Impacts Analysis:

EPA Environmental Justice Research grant

Document multiple/cumulative exposures, health outcomes, and disparities (compare to KC, Seattle, other neighborhoods)

- higher asthma hospitalization
- higher incidence of lung cancer
- shorter life expectancy
- other indicators pending CBPR

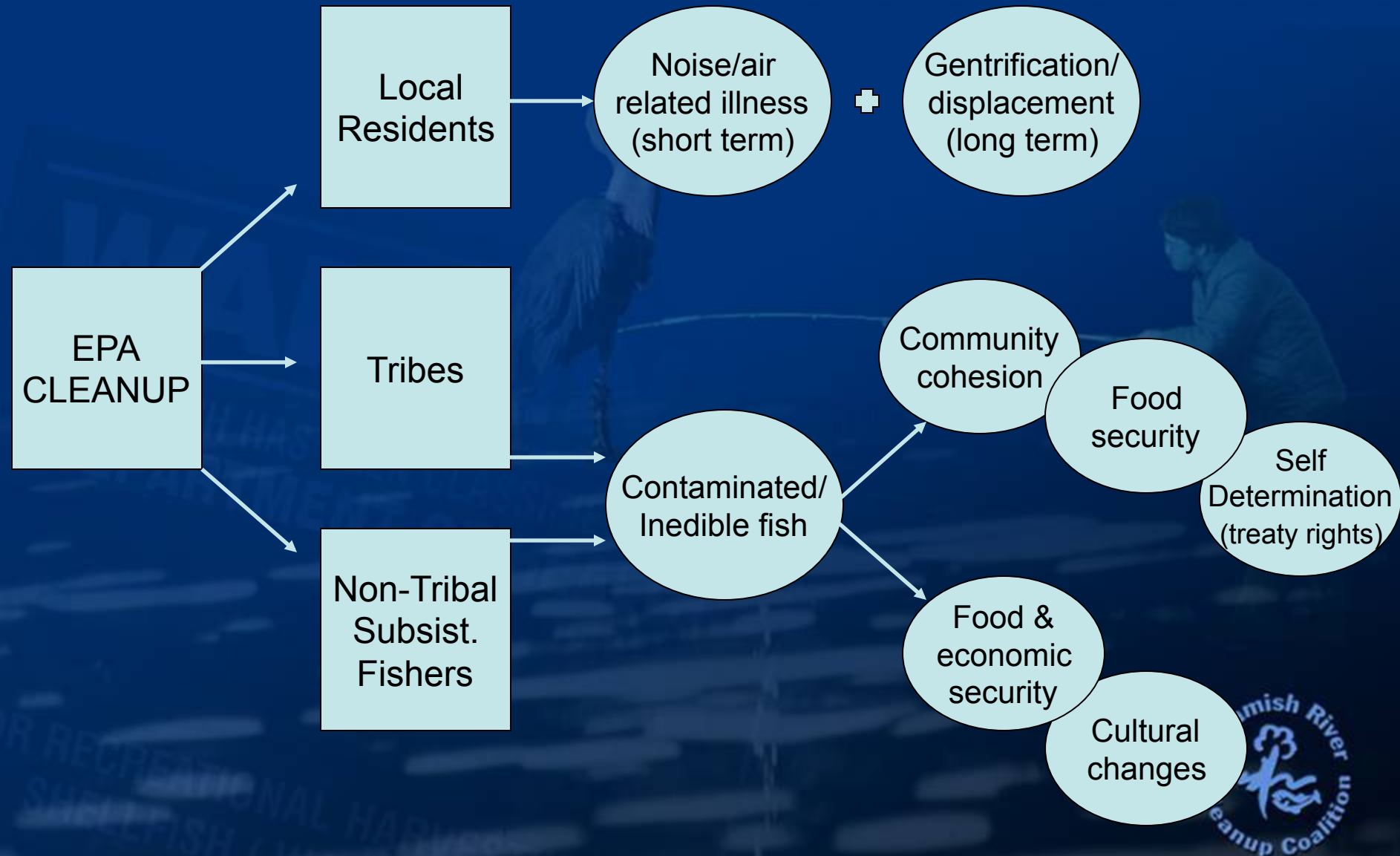


Possible areas for HIA assessment
